

Articles of Incorporation

The directors of TSC, all of Norman, were elected on September 15, 1969, with the purpose of incorporating TSC:

Macon Petty	Ray C. Snodgrass
William H. Mattoon	James M. Carson
Mark V. Miller	Tony Vaughn

The Articles of Incorporation were filed with John Rogers, Oklahoma Secretary of State on November 5, 1969.

Article One names the corporation as Thunderbird Sailing Club.

Article Two lists the office of William H. Mattoon as the address of the corporation, and he as its Registered Agent.

Article Three states, "The duration of the corporation is perpetual."

Article Four states, "The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is formed are: To promote water safety; to encourage the pursuit of sailing as a recreational activity and as a competitive sport; to teach the rules of sailing; to engender a spirit of sportsmanship among its members, their families and within the community; to promote the teaching of the methods, techniques and sciences of sailing to young people. To enter into such business transactions as are authorized by the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma governing charitable, benevolent, educational or scientific corporations."

Article Five states, "This corporation is formed for Educational purposes."

Article Six lists the signatures of the six directors.

The remainder of the document includes witness by a notary public, and certification by the Presiding Officer, Macon Petty.

The original document is held by the Thunderbird Sailing Club at the Lake Thunderbird Boathouse.
